

DIVISION G DELP REPORT

March 20, 2011

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Area G-1 gained a newly chartered club. The Del Talk-O club chartered on February 25 at the Del Taco offices in Lake Forest.
- OC Toasters (Area G-1), Coastmasters (Area G-2), and Money Talks (Area G-5) are all on track to become President's Distinguished clubs.
- Four other clubs are on track to become Select Distinguished clubs, and 10 other clubs are within reach of becoming a Distinguished club.
- Over 60% of Division G clubs are on track to complete the fiscal year as Distinguished or higher.
- Division membership has grown well over 6% so far in the current fiscal year.
- Area numbers look good as an indicator their DCP goal for ACs (67% completed).

ACTION ITEMS

- All Area Governors are set to complete their club visits before the end of March.
- All Area speech contests will be on the same day. The location is the Irvine Ranch Water District. Areas G-3 and G-5 will host their contests together in the morning, and Areas G-1, G-2, and G-5 will host their contests together in the afternoon.
- Mary Berg currently works on a plan to revitalize the membership roster in Area G-1 club, Lake Forest Toastmasters.

OPPORTUNITIES

- With a good closing team, Toastmasters could open a new club in the Lake Forest City Hall.
- Areas G-1 looks poised to become a President's Distinguished area.
- Area G-5 is on track to become a Select Distinguished Area.

CHALLENGES

- Area numbers indicate that Division G clubs may not complete their DCP goals for CCs (approximately 50% completed). This may be partly due to the high influx of people who are new to the Toastmasters education program, and the affective loss of two clubs in Area G-4.
- Area G-4 had two clubs who lost the bulk of their membership early in the fiscal year. While one of the clubs, Saddleback Valley, could regain charter membership levels within 12 months, the other, Ladera Ranch, would need extreme dedication to keep it up and going.
- Less than 50% of the clubs met DCP goals for officers trained.
