

**DEC REPORT  
DIVISION E  
March 23, 2011**

**Accomplishments:**

1. Division E Council Meetings, February 14 and March 14, were held at Siemens in Cypress.
2. Division E club officer make-up training was held on February 26 at Los Nietos, Whittier.
3. Clubs 3828 and 1456 were 100% trained. Total 98 officers were trained which was at 51.85%.
4. Spring speech contests for all five areas were finished with strong financial results.
5. Division E DCP status: 167 new members, 20 CCs, 10 ACs, 12 CL/AL/DTM.

**Challenges:**
