

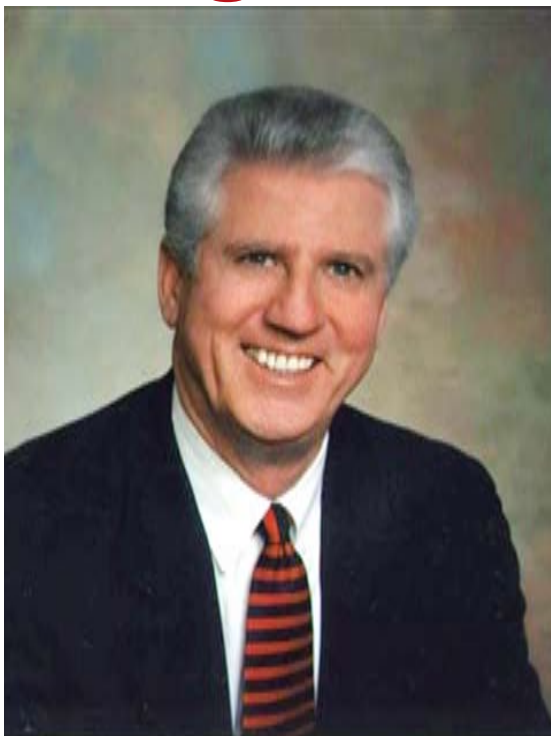

Swineford has been a member of Toastmasters International since 2004. He is a business owner, youth coach and qualified speaker with the Founder's District Speakers Bureau.

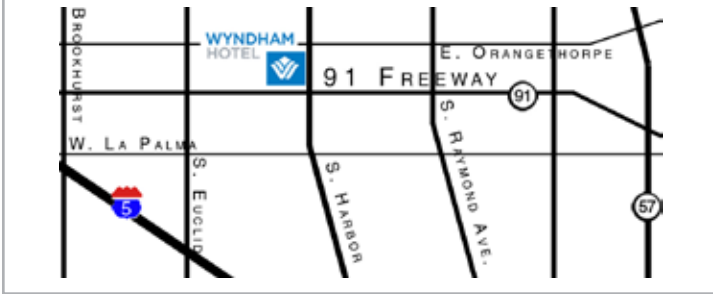


Give Yourself a Hand in Public Speaking Margaret Connery, CL and Jack Nichols, DTM
