#### **New Club Opportunities**

This year we have 13 clubs chartered so far. We have 6 clubs that have finished their demo meetings and have possible charter dates in April or May. An additional 5 clubs are confirmed and waiting to have their demo meetings scheduled in April with possible charter dates in April or May. 8 more clubs are currently in the works to begin the process of forming and we are optimistic these will be completed by end of June. One of the new leads is Blizzard Entertainment in Irvine. I expect a total of 25 to 30 new clubs for the year.

#### Renewals

We have 27 clubs that have not yet submitted dues but are expected to, two clubs that may not be able to renew, and 15 clubs that we know will not renew. We currently have 205 paid clubs. If the 27 unpaid clubs submit their dues and the 6 pending new clubs are chartered, that will put us in Distinguished territory. We'll need to add 9 more clubs to get us to President's Distinguished.

#### **Club Coaches**

We have assigned 5 new club coaches this month, though we still have 50 clubs that are in need of coaches. Our team has been working hard putting together our own hand-made club repair kits that we'll soon be delivering to selected clubs in need. These kits have all of the tools and information clubs need to help rebuild and strengthen their clubs.

#### **Incentives - Talk Up Toastmasters**

- Members of all clubs adding 5 or more members during Feb-Mar are invited to Pizza Party.
- 2. New members entered into a drawing to win two free tickets to the Spring Conference
- 3. All members paying dues by March 31 entered into drawing to win private speech coaching sessions.
- 4. Club with most members added by March 31 wins \$50 gift certificate.

#### **Membership Payments**

We have 8,919 payments to date and just need to reach 10,458 by June 30 for President's Distinguished. We are very much on target to hit that goal as renewals begin on April 1 and the rest or our new clubs complete chartering.

#### **Talk Up Toastmasters Award**

So far we have added more than 400 new members during February and March. 23 clubs qualified for the Talk Up Toastmasters award.

#### Pizza Party Planning

The pizza party is scheduled for Friday night May 6 in Anaheim. Cindy Carpenter is the keynote speaker with a brand new educational and interactive presentation to help you unleash your creative potential. We will also conduct the drawing for our private speech coaching giveaways. The main event will be a 40 minute immersive light and sound show celebrating space exploration and scientific innovation.

Over 800 people will be invited but there is a 200 person limit at this venue, so if the number of RSVPs exceed 200 we will consider adding a second show in the north area of the district.
