Completed

In Progress

- A new club was chartered on March 3rd in Santa Ana and was assigned to Area G5. It was a 4-week process including the lunch-and-learn, demo meeting, and two club meetings. This club serves one office of the Social Services Agency in Orange County. Other facilities are interested in starting up clubs.
- CCI Articulate Actuators in Area G1 has decided not to continue their club. Efforts
 to revitalize the club were not successful. We will take the loss during the 20162017 term. We are working to find a new club to start so G1 will not take a net loss.
- 3 clubs in Area G3 are looking for new venues because of changes at the corporate/government locations where they currently meet. These clubs are Ziggurat 425, UniMasters, and Fluent Philosophers. UniMasters is working with Soka University and held a demo meeting at their campus on 3/17. Fluent Philosophers is investigating other nearby businesses.
- David Hosmer is working with Ware Malcom to see if they have enough interest and people to start a new club.
